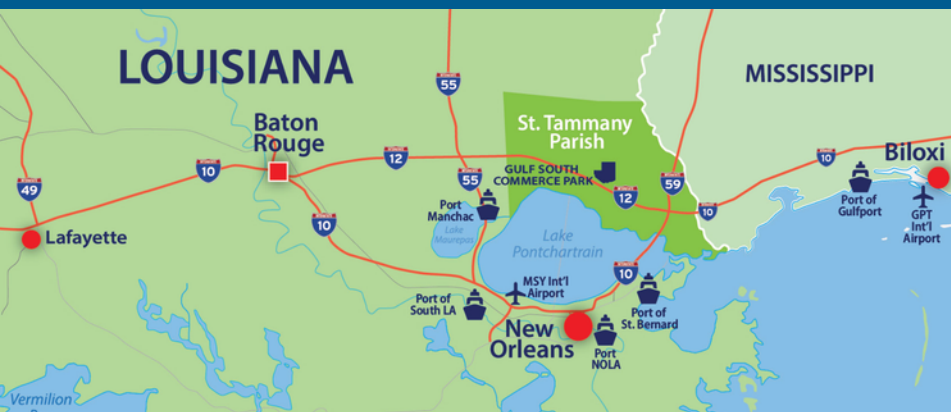

With its proximity to five main ports, St. Tammany Parish enables access to key markets.

← Deepwater Access, Inland Waterways

St. Tammany is close to the Port of New Orleans — Louisiana's only deepwater port, handling container, breakbulk and heavy lift cargoes — along with the ports of South Louisiana, Manchac, St. Bernard and Gulfport. These ports flow into 14,500 miles of waterways including the Mississippi River, transporting goods to the U.S. South, Midwest and Canada.



Louis Armstrong International Airport in New Orleans serves 59 destinations and 14 airlines.

← Top-Class Road, Rail and Air

St. Tammany gives real meaning to multimodal. Interstates 10, 12 and 59 intersect in the parish, with I-55 just a 20-minute drive away. Easy access to two international airports connects to dozens of domestic and global destinations. Norfolk Southern rail lines run along the parish's eastern side, and six Class I railroads in the region grant access to a 133,000-mile rail network.



St. Tammany's Gulf South Commerce Park offers nearly 1,000 greenfield acres, primed for scientific and technical operations.
